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reckoning with the colonial past to bring justice to the present as white settlers spread across north america they crafted and enacted an epic story of their god given dominion over the land over indigenous nations and over the future their narrative constructed a myth of innocence that justified a massive program of violence and dispossession by suppressing a darker history that history still reverberates today from settler america's relations with the indigenous nations of the united states to ways the land has been commodified as property it's time for the whole truth to be told in undoing manifest destiny I daniel hawk exposes the belief systems and practices that settlers developed to justify the displacement destruction and cultural erasure of indigenous peoples beginning in the early american colonial period and extending to the present day writing as the descendant of white settlers and as a biblical scholar he challenges settler christians to uncover what the settler narrative denies and to work toward addressing historic injustices in this book hawk combines settler colonial theory historical analysis and christian theology to examine how settler america sought to erase indigenous presence from lands taken by the united states and its colonial predecessors offers a decolonizing perspective that challenges the church to acknowledge its complicity with the colonial project and to enter into dialogue directed toward setting things right and highlights contemporary manifestations of colonialism in us interactions with its

indigenous citizens demonstrating that past issues are still present and need to be addressed today hawk asserts that christians were complicit with programs of erasure and so christians are called to confront and heal their residue today joining historical research with theology and biblical scholarship hawk helps us recognize the myths that shape the american imagination and to engage our faith for a better way forward this book is an invaluable resource for scholars educators students and readers invested in areas such as post and de colonial studies race and ethnicity united states history and social justice deepen your understanding of history confront unsettling truths and work toward justice and healing with undoing manifest destiny

this book illustrates why a holistic approach is important in pediatric palliative care ppc readers will learn this approach has a horizontal axis featuring the patients mental and physical needs as well as their environments it has also a vertical axis the evolutive changes of the patients throughout their development and their illness their aspirations and fears an evolutive or dynamic approach is mandatory each child parent has a different experience of illness and a different path to recovery that is influenced by their age gender culture but also by the state of their grief to take care of them we need to know the state of the subjects we are dealing with throughout their evolution in age children and in sorrow both children and parents jung s and piaget schemes will be of support this book also helps caregivers to know what ethics is it teaches a new insight on the word ethics not a series of principles or norms but an approach based on humanistic virtues two criteria will be proposed to this aim an ethics based on the refusal of inauthentic behaviors or those behaviors that are copies of animals or machines and a new criterion that even children have some ethical duties not based on rules but on naturally acceptance that their sight is modulated by the presence of their parents and friends this ethical approach is explained to caregivers in a practical mode ready for clinical exigencies this book is also unique because it demonstrates that ppc also involves the true care of caregivers it will explain how to approach measure and overcome caregivers burn out special attention is devoted to the approach to babies and children s pharmacological and non pharmacological analgesia and sedation pain assessment methods will be illustrated as well as the development of a ppc web on the territory this text includes perinatal and neonatal ppc the book will be of valuable support to all those intensivists pediatricians nurses psychologists physiotherapists and healthcare professionals working in ppc units

perspective on topics ranging from the historical underpinnings of autism treatment to the use of psychopharmacology and the implementation of ebps the book reviews the conceptualization of evidence based practices ebps as well as considerations for implementing such practices across settings in addition it describes emerging treatments though they cannot yet be considered evidence based that have produced limited but highly promising results the book also describes treatments and therapies that have been proved ineffective it explores ways in which ebps can be applied in inclusive school settings pediatric settings in patient treatment programs and college based programs for transition aged youth the volume describes outcomes from the development of ebp guidelines at the national level in scotland and more broadly in the united states and outlines how such guidelines can be adapted to offer more individualized intervention key areas of coverage include comprehensive treatment models including early intensive behavioral intervention pivotal response treatment early start denver model and naturalistic developmental behavioral interventions focal treatments addressing the core deficits of asd and its co occurring conditions social skills communication and the use of applied behavior analysis aba practices for teaching new skills and decreasing challenging behaviors sensory based interventions psychopharmacology cognitive behavior therapy and parent education programs e g project impact the handbook of evidence based practices in autism spectrum disorder is an invaluable resource for researchers professors and graduate students as well as clinicians therapists and all professionals working in the fields of developmental clinical child and school psychology pediatrics social work behavior analysis allied health sciences public health child and adolescent psychiatry early childhood intervention and general and special education
