1920s to critique of dialectical reason his largest political piece yet scholarly debate overwhelmingly concludes that his political philosophy is a marxist one in this landmark study william l remley sheds new light on the crucial role of anarchism in sartre s writing arguing that it fundamentally underpins the body of his political work sartre s political philosophy has been infrequently studied and neglected in recent years introducing newly translated material from his early oeuvre as well as providing a fresh perspective on his colossal critique of dialectical reason this book is a timely re invigoration of this topic it is only in understanding sartre s anarchism that one can appreciate the full meaning not only of the critique but of sartre s entire political philosophy this book sets forth an entirely new approach to sartre s political philosophy by arguing that it espouses a far more radical anarchist position than has been previously attributed to it in doing so jean paul sartre s anarchist philosophy not only fills an important gap in sartre scholarship but also initiates a much needed revision of twentieth century thought from an anarchist perspective
